We are Maison Khusi, a project created by 5 students of the University of Geneva as part of the "Projets Responsables" course.



Our mission is to renovate a building in West Bengal (India) and transform it into an orphanage for young children who lost their parents during the COVID-19 pandemic. They find themselves in the streets, left to themselves, starving, victims of prostitution, pedophiles and exploitation. Our main objective is to provide them a stable and secure family living environment. To do so, we need to raise the sum of 11'583 CHF.

We organized a Christmas raffle last semester and received multiple donations, which allowed us to raise a total of 9'167 CHF and to start the renovation of the orphanage.
